There is no size limitation for posters. Standard easels for 36 - 48 inch posters will be provided (if your poster is outside these parameters, you must provide your own easel).

All posters accepted for presentations will be reviewed by the Poster Presentation Subcommittee. Posters will be judged for awards during the time of presentation at the conference. Winners will be awarded during the conference.

All posters are expected to stay during the conference. Conference attendees will browse among the posters and discuss with the presenters. The Poster Session is expected to be informal and conversational.

ABSTRACT FORMAT AND SUBMISSION

Participants who wish to submit an abstract should use the format described below. Abstracts that do not meet the format will not be accepted. An electronic copy of an abstract should be submitted. Please note: An abstract MUST be in the following format to be considered for acceptance.

Style

The abstract should be 300 words or less, include name, title, background, objectives, methods and results or expected results. Type text of abstract using full justification. Mathematical symbols and equations must be typed in, and metric symbols should be used. Figures should not be included.

Format and Layout

Font Type: Times Roman
Font Size: 12 points
Line Spacing: Single

(1) **Title**: Type title of abstract in capital letters.

(2) Leave one blank line after the title section.

(3) Authors/Co-Authors

Affiliation(s): Type author(s) name in this order, a) last name, b) first initial

followed directly by a number in parentheses to indicate corresponding

affiliation(s).

Underline the name of the presenting author.

Example: Aman P (1), Doe H (1,2), Cman W(2)

(1) Institute for Optics, Jackson State University (2) Department of

Productions, University of Ukraine.

- (4) Leave one blank line after the author and affiliation section.
- (5) **Background**: All lines in text full justification.
- (6) Leave one blank line after the Background section.
- (7) **Objectives**: All lines in text full justification.
- (8) Leave one blank line after the Objectives section.
- (9) **Methods:** All lines in text full justification.
- (10) Leave one blank line after the Methods section.
- (11) **Results or Expected Results:** All lines in text full justification.
- (12) Please provide a cover page with your contact information email address, telephone, and Fax number. Do not write contact information on abstract.

Acknowledgement

Authors will be acknowledged of the receipt and status of their abstract.
